

C74 HEXAVALENT CHROMIUM IN SOIL

1.0 Sample Reception

- 1.1 All breakages and shortages must be reported within 24 hours of sample receipt.
- 1.2 Store samples at $4\pm2^{\circ}$ C upon receipt. Samples are unpreserved. Analyse as soon as possible to avoid degradation.
- 1.3 Check that all the parameters for which you are registered are correctly identified on the web data entry report page.

- 3.1 Results must be reported by midnight of the study deadline (see the General Proficiency Testing Information sheet included with the shipment for details).
- 3.2 Report RDL (optional) if you want RDL accounted for in z scores.

4.0 Safety

4.1 The PT samples are designed for use by laboratory professionals familiar with environmental samples and potentially hazardous materials.
